

## **EDUSPARK RESEARCH**

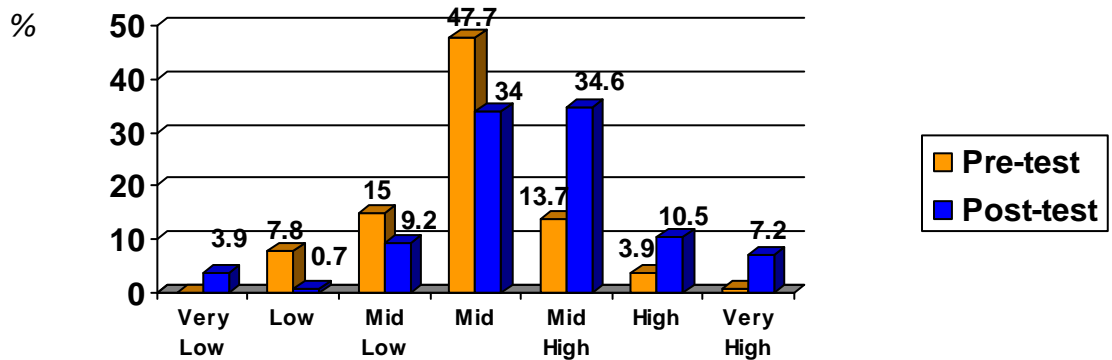
EDUSPARK has 10 years of research observing and demonstrating significant learning improvements in young children, specifically those in Kindergarten through Middle School. Some results follow:

- 1994-95:** 800 children tested in five public elementary schools in Nuevo Leon, Mexico with the support of the University of Monterrey.
- 1997-98:** 120 children tested in two private schools in Monterrey, Mexico.
- 2002-04:** 153 children tested in Guadalajara and Monterrey, Mexico, with statistical support from the University of Nuevo Leon.
- 2004-05:** 360 children tested in Ciudad Victoria, Mexico with the support of the Universidad La Salle.
- 2004-06:** 80 children tested in Monterrey, Mexico, with the support of the Universidad de Nuevo Leon.
- 2007-08:** 60 children tested in Miami Dade, USA. Dr. Suarez - R. Mc Laughlin Ph D.

The chart below summarizes research based upon students whose ages range from 4 to 12 years old. They were tested using the Kaufman Intelligence Test before and after using ***EDUSPARK's Learning System***, in some cases with a control group. Four basic programs were applied for sensory, motor, linguistic, and cognitive skills.
